HOW IT WORKS

To earn an *IMPACT* award, you must complete one of the following options **AND** submit your participation documentation using our online entry form by April 15 of your graduation year. Credit for planned activity after April 15 should be included in your submission.

OPTION 1: DONATE/RECRUIT



Over the course of your high school experience, donate blood at least 8 times **OR** recruit 8 new blood donors.

- Any combination of new recruits and personal donations will be accepted as long as you have 8 in total.
- Recruits cannot include other high school students at a high school drive, see website for details.

OPTION 2: HOST A DRIVE



Work with a Blood Center Recruiter to host a blood drive *(outside of your high school drive)* in January, June, July, August or December.

- Mobile/Community based blood drives must collect **15 units or more** to qualify, with no exceptions.
- Donor Center/In-Center blood drives must collect **10 units or more** to qualify, with no exceptions.
